"Preparation for the course" Steps before the course



"Getting started"- tasks (8 x 3h)

Starting study units

- Forming project groups in contact lessons 14. and 21.3.2017.
- Students tell their wishes, which "language" they are interested in: two wishes.
- Visit to Sopimuskoti with students
- Checking the student groups
- 19 students, 6 project groups,
 3-4 students in each groups

Planning the projects

- Goal-orientation: customers'v goals and students' own professional goals
- Customer-orientation and participatory in project work
- Argumentation why these goals and methods
- Evaluation how to collect feedback
- Introducing project plans 5.4.2017.
- Opponents' and lecturers' comments
- DISCRIBE YOUR CHALLENGE AT THE BEGINNING OF THE PROJECT USING YOUR OWN "LANGUAGE"
- Example music group

The manifest of creative activities – short films

- "Make a short film to argue in a creative way the importance of the creative method you are using in your project"
- Example, fysical exercise and dance group

Common lessons during the project work - support

- Make a short silly poem about your project, limitation 5 min
- Make a moving statue: If your project were a vechile, what it could be? how it moves, who is driver, captain or passengers...
- Ethical issues: make a cartoon processing your projects ethical issues. Use ready-made figures.
- Feedback: give positive feedback to your project partners. Choose 3-5 positive things to share with other groups.


